



## FENCE PERMIT APPLICATION

1. Attach a plot plan highlighting where fencing will be installed (See back for example). Include distance from front face of home and back of sidewalk, if applicable. Most lots and subdivisions have specific requirements for type, height, material, and location. Verify requirements with the Community Development Department, and if applicable, your Homeowners Association.
2. It is the responsibility of the property owner and/or contractor to locate your property lines and install fencing accordingly. Improperly installed fencing will be required to be moved or removed.
3. **Call 811 before you dig!** It is the homeowner/contractor's responsibility to call for utility locates prior to any digging.
4. A fence permit must be issued and displayed before any work begins.
5. Fences over 6 feet in height must apply for a building permit and may be subject to engineering requirements.

## **Dacono Residential Fence Regulations**

- (1) Retaining walls must conform to lateral pressure engineering specifications and shall not be unsightly or detrimental to abutting property.
- (2) Barbed wire or electric fences are not permitted.
- (3) Dilapidated, unsightly or dangerous fences shall be removed or repaired when so ordered by the Building Official.
- (4) For corner lots, front yard fence regulations shall apply to both street sides of the lot.
- (5) Front yard fence shall be constructed of chain link or split rail or other standard residential fence approved by the Building Official, except that no fence shall be constructed of plywood or particle board. Fences shall not exceed forty-two (42) inches in height and shall be fifty percent (50%) open space. Fence pickets shall not exceed six (6) inches in width. No front yard fence shall be constructed nearer than thirty (30) inches from the sidewalk or other public walkway. No fence shall enclose a meter pit.
- (6) Back yard fences may be constructed of masonry walls or any of the material permitted in Paragraph (5) above, and the walls may be solid. Maximum height of back yard fences shall be six (6) feet, said fence not to extend past the front side of a dwelling.
